**CENTRAL COMMITTEE MEETING OF CBSPRA HELD
COM K SURESH BABU CO-OPTED AS
GENERALSECRETARY**

We are happy to inform that the 37th Central Committee (CC) Meeting of CBSPRA was held on 16.3.2026 at 10.00 a.m. through Zoom Video Conference.

After initial formalities and homage to departed members, the CC reviewed the grand success of the 5th Triennial Central Conference & General Body Meeting and the Syndicate Bank Centenary held at Hyderabad and placed on record appreciation for the excellent services rendered by Hyderabad comrades.

It was also noted with happiness that Com. K. Suresh Babu, who had suffered a femur fracture on the eve of the Triennial Conference, is recovering well and is now able to participate in organisational matters.

The CC then considered the resignation submitted by Com. V. Krishna Kumar from the post of General Secretary keeping in view organisational functioning in the established pattern. The CC accepted his resignation and unanimously co-opted Com. K. Suresh Babu as General Secretary of CBSPRA for the ensuing term.

Com. Suresh Babu, who joined the meeting thereafter, thanked the members for their concern and support during his recovery and assured that he would continue to strive for strengthening the organisation.

The CC discussed the forthcoming AIBPARC General Body Meeting at Ernakulam on 28–29 April 2026 and endorsed the earlier decision regarding delegates and observers. Com. R. K. Verma (Lucknow) and Com. S. B. Sai Prakash (Bengaluru) were also included as observers on behalf of CBSPRA in the given circumstances.

The CC also considered the resignation of Com. S. Nagavelu (Chennai) from the post of Deputy General Secretary (one of the two positions held by him) and unanimously co-opted Com. Loganathan (Chennai) as Deputy General Secretary.

Other organisational matters including membership mobilisation, the ensuing GRC meeting with management, and the visit of Presidium office-bearers to Head Office, Bengaluru were also discussed.

The CC placed on record its appreciation for the services rendered by Com. V. Krishna Kumar, both as Chairman of the Reception Committee of the Triennial Conference and as General Secretary during the crucial intervening period. The yeoman services of Com. P. Kameswara Rao in the conduct of the Centenary programme were also appreciated.

The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Com. M. S. Prakash Rao, Treasurer.
